

The SASORLH&NS University Training Award

Objective:

To further the education and skills of (a) promising registrar(s) in Otorhinolaryngology.

To improve the training skills available to each department.

To have one award at each of the University ENT Departments. (Currently a total of eight).

Recipient Eligibility:

- * A member of the South African Society of Otorhinolaryngology, Head and Neck Surgery.
- * A registrar in Otorhinolaryngology at the University where the award resides.

Selection guidelines:

- * The candidate registrar(s) selected entirely at the discretion of the University ENT Department where the award resides.
- * To attend a recognised Course or workshop acceptable to the Executive Committee or Day Committee of the SA Society of ORL,H&NS.

Monetary Value and disbursement:

- * Only one award per annum to be allocated in that particular financial year. The award may be shared amongst any number of registrars at the discretion of the ENT Department. No award can be carried over to the next year to accumulate awards. Should an award not be made in any year then that allocation falls away.
- * The award will be for a maximum allocation of R20, 000-00. This figure could be reviewed or ratified annually.
- * Disbursement of funds will only be made against pro forma or actual invoices of expenditure for:

Registration
Travel and
Accommodation.

Source of funds:

- Funds from investment income.
- Educational Grant sponsorships from Drug Companies.
